
- \cdot Use tablecloths, table runners and coasters to help protect surfaces from scratching.

- · Polish your furniture every 3 to 6 months, making sure the surface is free from dust before you start.

DON'T


- · Do not place hot or wet items directly on the surface as they can leave marks which are difficult to remove.
- · Avoid direct sunlight, as this will cause colour change. If the furniture is in direct sunlight, move items like vases around to avoid spotting.
- \cdot Do not apply too much polish as this will build up and need to be removed with a wood-cleaning product

Periodically check and re-tighten all fasteners. When moving furniture always lift it rather than drag it.





To level your cabinet, use the leveling wedge(D)




